

## Interdivision Transfer Policy

### Into School of Engineering & Applied Science

Washington University embraces a student's opportunity to change academic majors, even across different undergraduate divisions on campus. Exploration and flexibility are attributes of an excellent undergraduate experience.

In order to ensure a proper background for success in the School of Engineering & Applied Science (SEAS), prior to an interdivision transfer request being accepted students must:

- 1) Complete at least one non-summer semester in residence at the WashU Danforth Campus the semester immediately prior to the requested semester of transfer
- 2) Successfully complete L59 CWP 100-College Writing 1 or its equivalent (or possess proficiency via acceptable examination scores as stipulated by SEAS)
- 3) Complete at least one 3-credit class within the intended major being pursued with a "B" or better grade
- 4) Achieve a cumulative GPA of at least a 3.0 or higher and "B" or better grades in math, science and courses taken in SEAS (some departments may require a higher GPA)
- 5) Demonstrate a high regard for academic integrity; students who were found to be in violation of the academic integrity policy may be required to delay their entry for a specified time as determined by the transfer dean
- 6) Meet with the transfer dean or a 4-year advisor in Engineering Undergraduate Student Services in 303 Lopata Hall to ensure curriculum plan is on track for progress toward graduation
- 7) Be aware that changing majors may result in taking additional semester(s) to graduate

These are the minimum requirements. Each student is evaluated on a case by case basis.
